He is the leader of the children club there. He said that now they have 7 members team working for the awareness of the children. His group promoting for use of safe drinking water in his village.

He is also promoting jute based activities among women group in the village also.

He and his friends told that they need a water filter at the local Maszid as more people used to come for Namaz. He told that for the development of children they need some game items for their recreation.

The important message he gave that, he and his group educating 60 children of his community. He as a leader with 3 other children namely; Sehnsha Alam, Md. Sayum and Md. Hira Seikh teach 60 local children under a tree; those have no facility for school education and poor. They gave 2 hours per day at afternoon for these children. He also told that they are facing problem of shortage of Notebook, Slate, Chalks and pencils and a black board also.

He is also aware of saving money. He told that once his team contacted bank manager for saving account, but the Branch Manager did not respond properly. They also meet the Block Officials regarding this issue. But because of their annual examination they had slow down the process for some time.

He is also aware for the birth registration and immunization of the children of his village. He developed tremendous confidence and leadership and skill. His willingness to do for his community is great.
